Implement patch management

Automate the process of sourcing, testing, and deploying patches to minimize the exposure window for vulnerabilities, reducing the time attackers take to exploit them.

Develop an incident response plan

Develop and maintain a well-structured incident response plan to manage and respond to zero-day attacks effectively.

Implement a robust restoration strategy

Implement a strong backup system and routinely test your backups to ensure quick and effective restoration in case of an attack.
